### **1) Fixed Assets**

- The Company has maintained proper records showing full particulars, including quantitative details of Fixed Assets.
- The Company has conducted physical verification of assets during the year. In our opinion, this physical verification is reasonable, having regard to the size of the company and nature of its assets. No material discrepancies were noticed on such verification.
- During the period, that Company has not disposed any of its fixed assets, affecting the going concern assumption.

### **2) Inventories**

- There Company did not hold any inventory during the period covered by this report hence we have not reported on the clause 4(2(b) &(c) of the Order.

As per the Information and explanations given to us , we are of the opinion that there is no default on the part of the company in service of the Principal amount of Loan.

7) **Internal Audit:** The provisions of this clause are not applicable to the company.


8) **Cost Records:** The Provisions of this clause are not applicable to the company.

Diluted earnings per share is computed by dividing the net profit or loss for the year by weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year as adjusted for the effects of all dilutive potential equity shares, except where the results are anti-dilutive.


